Discrimination A Review of Three Methods: Testing

Similarity testing is relatively new and is not well developed in the sensory field. Unlike discrimination testing, the objective of similarity testing is to demonstrate similarity rather than difference. Similarity testing uses the same sensory analysis methods for discrimination tests, but different statistical models.

Experimental Design and Sensory Analysis

Sensory testing refers mainly to discrimination, descriptive and affective tests. Discrimination and descriptive analysis are recognized as analytical tests to detect product differences or characteristics. In comparison,

affective analysis is defined as a hedonic test, which explores consumer likings or preference levels of the products.

Discrimination testing is a technique employed in sensory analysis to determine whether there is a detectable difference among two or more products. The test uses a group of assessors (panellists) with a degree of training appropriate to the complexity of the test (see also: trained panel) to discriminate from one product to another through one of a variety of experimental designs.
